PRESENTATION CRITERIA for GRADUATE Entries

Each student must submit electronically in PDF Format:

- I. 11"x17" Format Design Solution Booklet
 - a. Must include:
 - i. Cover Page with Project Title only (Logo OK)
 - ii. Lighting Plan
 - iii. Fixture schedule
 - Fixture Type and Image
 - Description
 - Manufacturer & Catalog Number
 - Lamp Source
 - Relevant Notes
 - iv. Design Narrative that addresses the following
 - Fixture selection choices
 - Lighting Techniques (grazing vs. washing, etc.)
 - Lamp Sources (efficiency, color rendition, dimming compatibility, etc.)
 - Maintenance (durability, accessibility, lamp life, etc.)
 - Compliance (IES recommendations, standards, and codes)
 - v. Control intent
 - Dimming and Switching layout
 - Zones with explanation of how they are used
 - vi. Title 24 Compliance Observations – include square footage of the project and comment on how it was taken into consideration in your design. Include the final wattage per square foot of the project.
 - vii. Graphical Representation of design intent – could be
 - Computer Renderings (AGI, Photoshop, 3D Studio, etc)
 - Scanned Hand sketches
 - b. May include as pertinent:
 - i. Elevations
 - ii. Details
 - iii. Architectural assumptions
2. One (1) page entrant contact information to be submitted as a separate file via the IESLA website.

DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME OR SCHOOL INFORMATION ON THE DESIGN BOOKLET - THE PROJECT NAME ON YOUR BOOKLET TITLE PAGE WILL BE USED TO MATCH IT WITH YOUR ENTRANT CONTACT INFORMATION.

Judging will be based upon:

1. Compliance with the above conditions – submissions not in compliance shall be disqualified.
2. Design concepts – including creativity of design and demonstration of a basic understanding of codes and IES recommendations for the given project type
3. Clarity and creativity of presentation

NOTE: FINALISTS WILL BE CONTACTED BY EMAIL OR TEXT BY MAY 1st. STUDENTS MUST CONFIRM THEY WILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE 7PM MEETING ON MAY 2nd WITHIN 8 HOURS OF NOTIFICATION OR THE NEXT HIGHEST SCORING STUDENT WILL BE CHOSEN. YOU MUST PRESENT AT THE 7PM MEETING TO WIN.
